Sculpture on the Peninsula will be held at Loudon Farm, Teddington , Banks Peninsula on 4,5,6 November 2011.Sculpture on the Peninsula is organised by the Lombardy Charitable Trust as a fundraiser for Cholomondeley Children's Home in Governors Bay.

While still maintaining the strong community involvement in the actual running of the event we are seeking to bring to the public an event that is representative of current art practise in New Zealand. Artists are requested to supply photographs and or working drawings of the work they intend to exhibit. Dr Feeney will select the work from the visual information given.

Artists can submit 3 works and or a collection of related objects for inclusion in the show.

Conditions of Entry

1. Art Work

Artists are able to submit 3 pieces of work or a collection of related objects for Sculpture on the Peninsula.

2. Selection and Award Judging

Dr Warren Feeney will select the work for Sculpture on the Peninsula 2011. The Sculpture on the Peninsula Award will be judged by Dr Feeney when all work is installed on sight. The Award winner will be announced at the Grand Opening on Friday 4th November.

3. Submission

By Post

Submissions are through photographs and or working drawings which must be of a size to be enclosed in an A4 sized envelope. The entry form must be completed and accompany the photographs and or working drawing. All photographs and working drawings must be clearly labelled on the reverse side with artists name and name of the work they refer to. All proposals will be retained by Sculpture on the Peninsula.

4. Deadline

All submissions must arrive at 47 Reserve Terrace, Lyttelton 8082 or gill@sculpturenz.co.nz by 5th July 2011.

5. Acceptance

All artists will be notified by post or email if they have been successful or not. Acceptance letters will be posted or emailed on 31 July 2011. Further information regarding installation and the event process will be included.

6. Sale

All work must be fore sale, a 37.5% commission inclusive of GST will be taken on sale of work.

7. Publicity

All exhibitors agree to the publication of reproductions of their work by the trust and by the media for the purpose of promoting the artist, the work and the objectives of the Trust at any time and without payment of commission or royalty.

8. Freight

Sculpture on the peninsula does not cover freighting costs.
