Conditions of Entry

Artists wishing to exhibit need to complete the submission form and supply photographs and/or working drawings by 5 July 2019 to gill @sculpturenz.co.nz or to 47 Reserve Terrace, Lyttelton 2082.

Each artist can submit 3 works and/or an installation of work for inclusion in the exhibition.

Art Work

All forms and sizes of sculpture in all materials are eligible for entry to Sculpture on the Peninsula. There is no size, style, content, or material restrictions on work submitted.

The exhibition site can accommodate the largest to the smallest sculpture. There are many different locations for work from hilltops to more formal garden area, along with farm sheds and stables.

Artists must give due consideration to the craftsmanship and durability of the work.

Site Specific Installation Work

Sculpture on the Peninsula particularly encourages installations. Specific areas on the property have been identified that would suit installations.

- Slaughter house
- Ridge line on top of hills
- Woodland area
- Old stables
- Significant trees
- Corrugated iron walls of farm buildings

Where artists are making a submission for an installation, they are encouraged to propose 3 sites in order of preference. If you are unfamiliar with the landscape and environment, please include in your submission a description of the type of location you would prefer.

Installation sites will be allocated according to appropriateness by the curatorial panel.
